# Bioeconomy initiatives of Steiermark region

Styria is one of the pioneers of the industrial bioeconomy in Europe and is specifically pursuing the transition to a sustainable and regional resource base. The Styrian volcanic region in particular, as the first Austrian model region for bioeconomy and circular economy, shows how economic development can be combined with resource conservation and climate fitness. The region focuses on the cascading use of raw materials, innovative biomass utilisation and the use of new biotechnological processes. This enables the production of bio-based products ranging from building materials to alternative proteins. Notable value chains and innovations can be observed in the efficient use of regional raw material in the wood-industry and agricultural side-streams. A rich environment of research and development activities, regional clusters and infrastructure-hubs make an important contribution to further bioeonomical development. Thanks to its established networks and expertise in raw materials, Styria offers potential for cooperation and testing new approaches. With a focus on the circular economy and regional value creation, the region creates economic stability and is open for innovation partnership.




